The Programme consists of:

Five Professional Studies based sessions, covering the latest educational pedagogy and practice, covering issues such as:

- Safeguarding/Child Protection
- Assessment for Learning
- Intervention & Inclusion
- Behaviour for Learning
- SEAL & ECM

and up to ten days school based experience, either in primary or secondary setting.

School Based Practice (Secondary)

- For secondary returnees, this will consist of up to ten days placement at Woodchurch High School in subject area(s) of their choice, where they will shadow staff and support teaching and learning.
- Placements will consist of up to ten days experience, either undertaken as a block practice or on a more flexible programme.
- Towards the end of the placement, the returnee will deliver two lessons and be formally observed by a member of the school staff who will write-up their observations.

School Based Practice (Primary)

- For Primary returnees, this will consist of ten days placement at a local school, recommended by the Local Authority, which has agreed to work with Woodchurch High School in this programme.
- Returnees will be attached to Year Band(s) of their choice, where they will shadow staff and support teaching and learning.
- Placements will consist of ten days experience, either undertaken as a block practice or on a more flexible programme.
- Towards the end of the placement, the returnee will deliver two lessons and be formally observed by a member of the school staff who will write-up their observations.

Validation

Upon completion of the five Professional Studies Sessions, and the ten-day School Based Practice, the returnee will receive two written evaluations of their teaching and a final report, detailing the programme they have followed, plus any obvious areas of strength and/or areas for development.



*This 'Returner's course' is fully funded by both the TDA and Wirral MBC, although 'Returners' will be expected to contribute towards the cost of their enhanced CRB check, as organised by school.
NB: as CRB checks can take up to ten weeks, please register your interest as soon as possible.*
